Referred by school/ the Education Bureau/ welfare agencies. Participants should pass the interview.

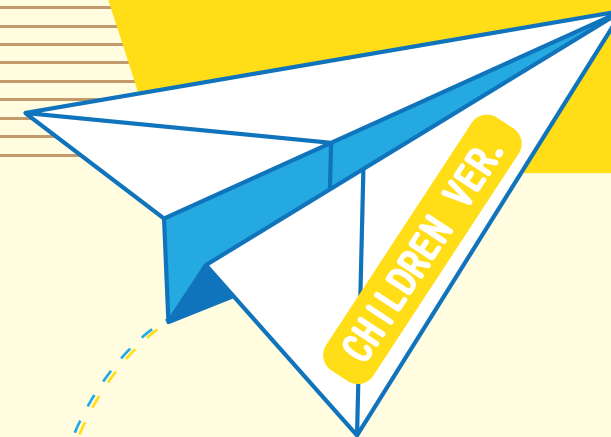

THE FIRST PHASE (8 WEEKS)

Course will be held on long holidays or after class. It will not affect the normal schedule for students to go to school
